

Background

- 80 strips of sashing cut at 2" x 9 1/2"
- 4 squares at 14" cut TWICE diagonally to get 16 setting triangles. You'll only need 14 of these along the outside edge of your quilt
- 2 squares at 10" cut ONCE diagonally to get 4 corner triangles.

Medium/Darks

- 28 squares cut at 2" Use these squares as your cornerposts to connect your sashing strips.
- 5 squares cut at 3 3/8" Cut these TWICE diagonally to get 20 quarter- square triangles. You'll need 18 of these to use as the cornerposts on the outside edge of your quilt.

Using the quilt diagram as your guide, sew the blocks, sashing and corner posts and setting triangles together in diagonal strips. Sew the strips together to create your quilt.
